Rimefire Sporter Clinic & Match

To fill the void of the unfortunate withdrawal of the 2020 National Matches from the annual schedule, the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) have prepared a solution that will allow all of our competitors to compete with one another during the summer months, from the comfort of their local ranges.

The CMP "Home Range Appreciation Series" is a collection of rifle, pistol, CMP Games, smallbore and air rifle competitions (open to both adult and junior athletes), that will be fired in local club matches and compared against overall scores from around the nation.

These matches are focused on promoting match participation at the local level, and cover a wide range of shooting disciplines, including highpower rifle, pistol, games events, air rifle and smallbore. What makes these matches unique is that the scores from all the matches will be complied together, and all participants will receive a commemorative t-shirt and coin. At the completion of the match, a fee of \$5.00 per competitor for each event is due to CMP that is covered by your match fee.

The clinic is free of charge. The clinic will start at 8:30 AM and relays will start at 11:00 AM. The match fee is \$15 for adults and free for juniors (10 - 17 years old). Adults are required to fill out a CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement and have it notarized (a current photo ID is required). There will be a notary available at the club during registration. The cost of the notary is covered in your match fee.

Classes: Open, Telescopic, and Tactical Unlimited Classes - Achievement Medals per CMP Cut Scores.

Match: 60- shot course of fire with precision and rapid-fire stages in prone, sitting, and standing positions.

Equipment: .22LR Caliber Standard Rimfire Sporter Type rifle not exceeding 7.5 pounds with sights. Trigger must hold 3 pounds. Rifle scope, Red Dot, or open sights may be used. Telescopic sight will be taped to 6x power maximum. A sling, not more than 1 ½ inches wide, may be attached to the rifle using a fixed, non-adjustable sling swivel (no adjustable hand-stops or rails). The sling must be simple leather, synthetic, or web strap. The sling may not have any special padding, lining, or asymmetrical construction. The sling may be used to support the rifle in the prone and sitting or kneeling positions. The sling may not be used to support the rifle in the standing position, but it may remain attached to the rifle or it may be detached from the rifle during. U. S. military leather or web slings may be used (see Rule 3.6.1). Shooting mat allowed, work-style glove for support hand allowed. Sweatshirt allowed, no shooting jackets. Spotting scope is okay. ECI Empty Chamber Indicators required and will be provided. Eye and ear protection required. Bring 60 rounds for match plus additional ammo for sighters. There will be rifles and shooting mats available to use at the club. Ammunition will be available to purchase.
